The New Examination Rules of SCTE&VT, Odisha has been circulated vide Memo No. 4645 dt. 20/11/2018. Doubt have been raised from some quarters over some provisions of the said Rule. As per the provisions in Rule 27 of the said Rules, following clarifications are hereby issued for better interpretation of the said Rules.

1. Admission in higher semester (from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>(PT)) shall be allowed to those students as per clause 13.1 and Readmission in any semester(other than 1<sup>st</sup> semester) shall be allowed as per clause 14. It is clarified that, the admission to any semester other than 1<sup>st</sup> semester, shall be allowed to the students who satisfy the following conditions
  - (a) He/she must be eligible securing required percentage of attendance for the previous semester
  - (b) He/she must have Registered for Examination and must have paid Examination Fees of Full prescribed amount to the council for the previous semester.
  - (c) He/she must have passed all subjects of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to get admission to 5<sup>th</sup> semester in addition to the above two conditions.
2. The students who do not satisfy the above conditions 1(a) and 1(b)) are eligible for readmission whenever such semester is available in the immediate next academic session only.
3. Readmission in 1<sup>st</sup> semester is not allowed as per clause 14.3.
4. The sub-rule 5.5.1 to 5.5.8 referred in clause 13.1 may be read as 5.4.1 to 5.4.8 respectively.
5. The prescribed "minimum 35% marks in each theory paper including the internal assessment marks" at clause 10.1 means one has to secure a minimum of 35% marks in each Theory subject in End Semester exams. He/she is also to secure minimum 35% marks in End semester exams and Internal Assessment taken together in any subject. For Example, one has to secure minimum 28 marks out of 80 in each end semester exams and minimum 35 marks out of 100 including Internal Assessment.
6. The clause 14.3 bearing provision " Readmission is not allowed in 1<sup>st</sup> semester" may be read as clause 14.4 instead of 14.3
7. The clause 22 bearing provision " Retention period of Documents" may be read as clause 23 instead of 22

## **SCTE&VT Examination (Amendment) Rules, 2021**

1. The Rule 5.1 in the original rule shall be substituted ,namely:-

The Council shall conduct examinations twice in each academic session one at the end of Winter Semester (preferably in November-December) for the students of odd semesters i.e. Regular & Ex-Regular students of 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester and at the end of Summer Semester (preferably in April-May) for the students of even semesters i.e. Regular & Ex-Regular students of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semesters. The examination schedule shall be decided & notified by the Council.

2. The Rule 5.4.2 in the original rule shall be substituted ,namely:-

He has to submit his/her application for Examination Registration through online web portal to the Controller of Examinations through the head of institution supported by certificates/documents as required.

3. The Rule 5.4.8 in the original rule shall be deleted.

4. The Rule 10.1 in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

10.1. (i) Subject to other provisions in this Rule, a candidate shall pass in the semester end examination conducted by the Council only if he/she:-

(a) has secured a minimum of 35% of marks in each theory paper, excluding the internal marks; and

(b) has secured a minimum of 35% of marks in each theory paper, including the internal marks; and

(c) has secured a minimum of 50% of marks in each practical paper; and

(d) has secured a minimum of 40% of total marks in that semester.

10.1 (ii) In individual subjects in which examination is conducted in two parts separately, the total marks obtained by the candidate in both the parts shall be taken together to determine whether he has secured the minimum percentage of marks to pass in that subject.

5. The Sub-Rule 10.2 (i) in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

50% of the marks obtained by the candidate in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and 100% of the marks obtained in 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Semester by the candidate in 3 years courses.

6. The Sub-Rule 10.2 (ii) in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

50% of the marks obtained by the candidate in the 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters and 100% marks of the rest semesters for 4 years (part time) courses.

7. The Rule 12.5 is to be inserted in the original rule, namely:-

The Council reserves the right to cancel the examination of candidates who are found not eligible as per Examination Rules or otherwise & forfeit the examination fees paid by such candidates.

8. The Rule 13.1 in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

Subject to other provisions in this Rule, a student can be allowed to attend classes in subsequent semester provided that he/she has registered for appearing in the examination in the current semester on payment of prescribed examination fees.

9. The Rule 14.1 in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

A student who has discontinued his/her studies in any semester can seek readmission in the same semester by paying requisite fees as prescribed by the Council.



10. The Rule 14.2 in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

Students who have studied in any of the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> semester but could not qualify to appear in the examination due to shortage of attendance or any other reason have to seek readmission in the same semester and after attending required number of regular classes shall be allowed to appear in the examination.

11. The Rule 14.3 that read as "readmission is not allowed in 1<sup>st</sup> Semester" shall be renumbered as 14.4.

12. The Rule 16.10(iii) shall be substituted, namely:-

The transfer process will complete within 20<sup>th</sup> May each year, but it will be effective at the beginning of 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester only.

13. The Rule 18.6 in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

Council will notify the mark, if the change in mark is more than 10% of full marks of the paper concerned or if such change in mark results in his pass in the subject.

14. In Rule 23 of the original rule the statement against "written answer books" shall be substituted, namely:-

Upto beginning of next Semester Examination.
